# Denture and Partial Denture Replacement Clarification of Exceptions

## What's Happening with Dentures?

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has clarified the rules for replacing dentures and partial dentures. Currently, DHCS lets people get new dentures and/or partial dentures every five years. But sometimes, there are special situations where people need new dentures sooner than that.

## The Exceptions: When Can You Get Replacement Dentures Sooner Than Every Five Years?

- 1. Circumstances Beyond Your Control: If something happens to your dentures and/or partial dentures and it is not your fault, you might be able to get new ones sooner. You will need to demonstrate the following:**
  - Your provider must provide proof you still need dentures or partial dentures.
  - Explain how you lost your dentures or partial dentures and explain why this loss was outside of your control.

- Explain what steps you will take to prevent losing them again.
  - If the fire department, police, or some other official agency was involved, include their report if you can.
- 2. Medical Reasons: Sometimes, your old dentures just do not work well anymore.**
- Maybe you had surgery, an accident, or other circumstances that changed your mouth shape.
  - If so, your doctor or dentist can recommend new dentures and/or partial dentures for medical reasons.
- 3. Damaged Dentures: Sometimes, your dentures break.**
- If your dentures have broken, your provider must provide proof (1) the dentures cannot be repaired; and (2) you still need dentures or partial dentures.
- 4. Replacement for Other Reasons**
- If your dentures and/or partial dentures are lost or misplaced, a replacement may be granted twice per lifetime. The Member must create a plan to make sure the replacements are not lost or misplaced again; this is needed to make sure there is no need for future replacements. Documentation must include an explanation of preventive measures instituted to reduce the need for further replacement. Additional requests for replacement over the two per lifetime will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Remember, these rules help make sure people get the right care for their teeth!
